

FROM THE PASTORAL ASSISTANT...

By the time you receive and read this newsletter, we will have a new synodical Bishop. The Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, of which Hope is a member congregation, met in assembly May 29-31 at Split Rock Lodge in the Poconos to conduct its business. Approximately 1000 voting members and visitors attended. The highlight of the assembly was the election of a synodical Bishop.

Even as I write this article two days prior to the assembly, no one but God alone knows who will become our new Bishop. Unlike the national political scene, potential candidates do not openly conduct election campaigns. Any ordained pastor of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America is considered a candidate and it is believed that the Holy Spirit will select and bring to the position the individual best suited for the task.

The election of a Bishop is important and exciting business. It is one of God's ways of changing and renewing his church. Each congregation and every member will in some way be impacted by this change in leadership. A new Bishop will select some new staff members – again, change and renewal. Staff changes bring new and different relationships with congregations. In short, the winds of change are blowing in our synod and that's a positive happening when the winds are generated by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Hope Lutheran Church's voting members for the assembly are Pastor Kuntz, Mrs. Vicki Steiner and Mr. Wayne Weidner. Council President, Mrs. Linda Mery and I will attend as nonvoting visitors.

As always, this is a time for prayer. With Pastor Kuntz's retirement at the end of August and the synodical situation bringing more change, I invite and encourage your earnest prayers for God's guidance and wisdom.
