



The mentoring program is designed to pair an adult member of our congregation with a student for various meetings/activities during the school year. The purpose of the mentoring program is to broaden the learning opportunities for our students. It is one way of helping young people

to become committed followers of Christ. Effective learning often takes place through relationships. We think our young people can benefit from relating to another adult member of our faith community. It is not designed to teach a body of knowledge or information. While young people need to know the doctrines of faith, they also need someone who can help them understand what it means for baptized people of God to love one another, to encourage one another, to pray for one another and to build up one another in faith. Our mentoring program starts halfway through the Level I year, so we will be starting to look for Level I mentors very shortly.


