SUMMARY:						

Income exceeded expenses in the Regular Fund for the month of November by \$5,094.00, and for the year 2014, expenses exceeded income by \$29,290.59, giving us a current balance in the Regular Fund of \$48,342.18. Last year the net income for the same period was \$(39,902.23) with a balance of \$49,101.38.

Budget Comparison--Total Regular Fund Budget for 2014 is \$416,769.00. 48/52 of that figure is \$384,709.92. Our receipts in the Regular Fund for the eleven months were \$338,974.49. So, we are behind in income by \$45.735.43.

#### From Pastor Jami Possinger

As I write this newsletter article, Christmas has not even happened yet – we are still preparing for the birth of the Christ child. We are still focusing on the gift of a child who comes for us – to save us – to show us God's love – to call us to share that love with others. But in many other ways Christmas is already here. Why? How? Because we have shared the spirit of Christmas – we have spread the light of Christ with many people – some who we know and others who are unknown to us.

It was a joyous celebration and the thank you Hope Lutheran received was heartfelt. The light of Christ is shining.

But that wasn't all...we heard about another family who needed some help and Hope adopted the family for Christmas. Over 100 tags were placed on the wall for members to take and purchase practical items – and a few toys - for this family of six. The gifts came piling in and we set a date for anyone who wanted to help wrap them and load them to be delivered. Taking credit for things very often seems to require a lot of effort, doesn't it? And sometimes we "need" to make sure that someone else doesn't take credit for something that we've done, don't we? Or do we? What would happen if we were just to accomplish the things we wish to accomplish without worrying about who got credit for them? What if it didn't matter one bit to us whether we were given credit or not? What would our accomplishments look like?

My hunch is that they'd increase rather dramatically. If we don't worry about being recognized for our contributions, then we also won't worry too much about following up on our accomplishments to see who's been affected by them, and the time and energy that we won't spend making sure that what we did was noticed and appreciated can be spent on something new, something different, something beneficial to someone else.

Getting credit is nice. It's wonderful to feel appreciated and to have other people recognize our achievements. But our achievements are the results of gifts that we've been given, so we have to keep in mind that we are fortunate to have been blessed with such gifts. And wanting recognition is to saddle ourselves with expectations — and these expectations may not be met, which can bring us down.

Of course, we don't want someone else always taking credit for what we've done, but what's wrong with accomplishing something and not worrying a bit about who gets the credit? When we don't worry, we can move straight on to the next things in our lives, and fully enjoy doing so. Keep in mind that letting go isn't the end of the world, it's the beginning of a new life.

This monthly feature explores Hope's "Hidden Gems," to focus on the ministries and happenings that might fly under the radar of members. Learn and grow in the many facets of Hope. Maybe find a gem of your own!

Altar Guild is one of the functions of Hope that when everything goes well, no one notices, and that's the way they like it. How do the correct hymn numbers magically appear on the board? Who drapes the altar in its seasonal (and clean!) paraments? And how do the wafers get in the proper place before Pastor Jami needs them? It's not sleight of hand at all, but a dedicated team effort. "It is a great ministry for people who like to have an impact behind the scenes" said Karen Koplin, a long time team member.



Here at Hope Cherryville, Altar Guild teams are made up of adult and confirmed youth members who maintain the altar linens and paraments, and prepare the altar for all services throughout the liturgical seasons of the year. Currently, Hope has five teams comprised of two to five people that rotate monthly and are tasked with before, between and after worship duties.

Usually on a Friday, a team will meet at Hope and get to work preparing the sanctuary. They change the hymn numbers and the linens on the altar, among other things on their checklist. Between services, they tidy up the hymnals and pews, and depending on which service holds communion, make the necessary preparations for it. After worship, they take care of the altar flowers and get them ready for sponsors to take home and washing anything that was used so it's ready for the next service. Altar Guild also dry cleans or launders the linens as necessary and polishes candle holders, offering plates and the book stand on the altar.

Furthermore, Altar Guild is also responsible for setting up the sanctuary for baptisms, including preparing the font, candle, and the oil for anointing. Trudy Mertz does much of the behind the scenes tasks, like ordering supplies such as wine and wafers.

Small Altar Guild teams could always use more people and additional teams would help fill out the calendar year. If you're interested, Karen Kopland, or Jane Tretiak in the office would be able to provide further information.
