

GREETINGS FROM THE PASTOR... From Pastor Jami Possinger

By the time you receive this newsletter, Pastor Brian Rajcok will be getting ready to start his first pastoral call at Hope Lutheran Church. It is an exciting time for all of us and we will all be finding our way together. I know we have good intentions when we want to show him something in the church, share ideas for ministry, tell him how things have been done here – but it can be overwhelming for him at first. So I thought I'd share some suggestions that have been helpful to me at the start of a new call. Here are my "*Pastor Brian Welcome Tips*"...



- Pray for him daily. Truly, there is no greater comfort for a pastor than to know people are praying for him or her. I can literally feel it at times. On an especially stressful day, I sense God's presence by the prayers of God's people.
- Love and honor him. This includes helping him acclimate to the community. Let him have adequate time at home. Let his time off be honored as much as his church time.
- Tell him your name... again. And again. And again. Learning names may be the hardest thing a new pastor has to do. Remember you only have to learn one name he has to learn 1,300! So please... give him ample time to learn yours.
- Don't gossip about him. If you don't understand something... ask. Be very careful not to propagate misunderstandings. Be a positive voice and stop gossip and rumors as soon as you hear them.
- Speak words of encouragement. Say, "Pastor, I'm here to help." And mean it.
- Let him set his pace. It will take a while for him to figure out his stride. Give him your understanding during this time. He may not do everything you want him to do when you want him to do it. Let him set the pace.
- Don't offer a million suggestions. There will be time for that, but he needs time to learn the church. We are already doing lots of things some good and maybe some not so good he'll figure that out. Give him time to learn who we are as a church.
- Don't prejudge. He will make his own mistakes. Don't assume, based on his history or your expectations of him, that he will perform a certain way. He may. He may not.
- Stop in his office to say "Hi." But don't stay too long. There is a lot to learn and a lot to do in a new position and he will need some time and space for himself.
- Extend the honeymoon. Honestly, it usually seems too short anyway. He needs time to acclimate. He needs time to learn about our church and our members. Keep loving and supporting him even if he makes a change that is hard for you to accept.

Remember... God brought him here. God wants to use him here. Let God use Pastor Brian as God intended.

CHURCH ORCHESTRA – Reformation Sunday

Hope Church is fortunate to have an in-house, inter-generational orchestra available for festival services of worship. Creating an ensemble with this flexibility and diversity of talent is only possible through careful and meticulous planning. Frequently, customized music is prepared for the players based upon their ability and the available instrumentation for each service. It is for that reason we require new members to sign up with the director in advance of playing with the orchestra for the first time. No audition is required however a minimum of two-years playing experience is needed.

The orchestra does not rehearse on a regular basis. Rather, rehearsals are concentrated to just a few weeks prior to a scheduled service. Rehearsals are posted on the church website calendar and attendance is required. The days the orchestra typically plays are: Christmas Eve, Easter, Reformation, Pentecost and occasional "special assignments". The type of ensemble may change for each service which is contingent upon the available instrumentation.

Our next service will be on Reformation, Sunday, October 25th at both services. New members can sign up by emailing the director at <u>organist@hopecherryville.org</u>. Existing members can indicate availability by responding to the forthcoming Doodle survey.
