My mom was a person at her church in upstate New York who used to send birthday greetings and that is why she probably bought the box in the first place. Having used all the cards, she started to fill it with things she found interesting. When she passed away, I inherited the box.

A lot of columns torn out of the paper from Erma Bombeck, a small booklet from Helen Steiner Rice. I have mailed some of the special clippings to others when I thought it was needed.



Recently, while going through some of the inspiring pieces, I found a short one called "Things I Learned from my Mother". There is no author and I've seen other quips like this.

My mother taught me about **LOGIC**. "Because I said so, that's why."

My mother taught me about **STAMINA**. "You'll sit there until all that spinach is gone."

My mother taught me about **WEATHER**. "This room of yours looks like a tornado went through it."

I know many of us have learned a wealth of information from our mothers. My mother taught me the names of flowers and to look for the birds in the sky. She taught me a prayer for when I went to sleep. She taught me how to be kind and to share. I'm sure you can make your own list of what mother has taught you. We can thank God for the good things and learn to forget the not so good! Remembering that God says to our parents, "I'll lend you for a little while, a child of mine" give thanks for those who have raised you.



## **COMMITTEE SHOWCASE Hope Friendship Dance**

It's 7 p.m. and the dance floor at Hope Lutheran Church is packed. When the pulsating beat of the Macarena comes on Joel starts jumping up and down with joy. "I love the Macarena" Joel says as he twists his arms and hips to the lively music. Joel is a special needs young man as all of the people who attend the dance. One father said his son used to be shy about dancing until Darlene Pioli began organizing the dances. Now you can't get him off the dance floor.

Darlene and Charles Pioli started the dances in 1994 when her own special need foster children needed a place to interact with people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. She contacted Pastor Kuntz and the rest is history. Our DJ, Tony Allen, has been with the dances since 1997.

In the beginning the dances were poorly attended until the word got out. Then about 100 people, some from as far away as Bangor and Hellertown, attended the dances held each month at the church.

While the Piolis had many foster children come through their doors, their first long-term placement was Lanette in 1989 followed by Jackie and Sarah. All three girls were mentally challenged. Charlie and Darlene also had three natural children.

Under the Pioli's care they all blossomed and grew. Sometimes people wanted to pat Darlene on the back and she said she didn't like that as she got very embarrassed. She said I just give them the basic things we all need like a home, love, structure and a chance. Around 1982 Darlene was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis. There were days she was tired but she focused her energy caring for the children instead of feeling sorry for herself.



Darlene and Charlie hosted these dances for over twenty years. Sadly, Darlene passed away in 2016 but her legacy continues with the Hope Friendship Dances held once a month from September thru May.

Charlie and Lanette are still involved with the dances. These dances are held for special need adults 18 years and older.

There are now about 40 dancers on dance evenings along with their caregivers. Some dances have themes such as Christmas when Mr. & Mrs. Claus and "Jingles" the Elf ap-

pear. We have a Halloween Dance, Valentine Dance. St. Patrick's Dance and Easter Dance complete with the Easter Bunny. The May Dance is a Patriotic Pizza Party.

Presently our volunteers are Dolores Reenock, Kim Eckroth, Loretta Weil, Larry and Kathy Creyer, Charles Pioli, Linda Forand and Judy Dieter.




